Why is IPv6 important?

The Internet is a huge success story that underpins much of the world's ICT infrastructure today **BUT** "Peak IPv4" is nearly upon us. This will see the last central block of IPv4 addresses allocated to Regional Internet Registries (RIRs) at the end of 2010. The impact on users will be that they will not be able to get new public IPv4 addresses 12-18 months after that.
